

## MESSAGE FROM THE COVID TEAM

In line with the lifting of Government restrictions (Step 4), the Club no longer requires face masks or social distancing on the Club premises. However, as you will be aware, this virus has not gone away and there is still a significant risk of passing on infection. So we would ask all members to act in a way which protects the safety of others, particularly those who still feel vulnerable. For example, we should avoid having too many people close together indoors, and maintain some level of distancing.

**Face Masks:** It is an individual's choice whether to wear a face mask or not.

**Changing rooms and showers:** These are fully open but please change and leave so that the rooms do not get crowded.

**Galley and Bar:** Normal service, but please make the queues more spread out than before.

**Wednesday evening:** There are tables inside the clubhouse as well as outside. There are also tables upstairs in the Mossman room for folk in dry clothes to eat! As far as possible, one person from each table should collect food from the hatch or collect drinks from the bar to minimise congestion near the hatch and bar.

**Ventilation:** Windows and doors will be kept open to ensure good ventilation of the clubhouse. We aim to ensure appropriate ventilation in the club for the autumn.

**Tracing:** The QR code is still available.
