Notice of Race (NoR)

1 RULES

- 1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2** RRS 63.5 (c) (2) is changed so that in the event of a conflict between the NOR and the ESI, the ESI will take precedence.
- 1.3** (NP) (DP) Personal Flotation Devices shall be worn at all times whilst afloat in accordance with RRS 40.1 & RRS40.2 (c)

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1** The sailing instructions will be available by Friday 17th October 2025 on the club website.
- 2.2** The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1** The official notice board is located in the clubhouse.
- 3.4** [DP] [While racing][From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day], except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1** The event is open to all boats of the Cadet Class where the helm is a member of the UKNCCA
- 4.2** The entry will be divided into Gold, Silver and Regatta fleets in accordance with the UKNCCA protocol.
- 4.5** Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form before Tuesday 14th October 2025.

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fees are £15 per boat

5.2 Late entry fees (on or after 15 October 2025) will be £30 per boat.

6 CREW LIMITATIONS

6.1 The following crew limitations apply: Helms and Crews must be aged 17 or under on the 31st December in the year of the event.

6.2 Helms may not be substituted during the event. If the helm is changed the new helm will need to register as a new entry in the event. Crews may be changed only in exceptional circumstances and with written permission of the race officer.

15.4 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores as detailed below.

15.5 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 4 to 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 7 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks.

These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats,

The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to what can be practically provided in the circumstances.

- 23.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
